The Vehicle Accident Checklist gives invaluable information if you are in an accident or come upon and accident. The rest of the booklet is set up like a typical accident insurance form.

Printed on paper that is easily written on, this guide is a perfect addition to your car safety kit. It includes space for recording witness names as well as sketching the accident details.

If you are Involved in an Accident

- Keep calm.
- Stop as soon as you can.
- Offer assistance and give aid to the injured.
- Call the appropriate law enforcement agency (local or regional Police) immediately to report any accident resulting in injury to any person, or motor vehicle damage.
- If **no** personal injury is involved and damage is less than \$500, vehicles should be moved to clear the traffic flow.
- Complete as much of the information in this booklet as possible including names of witnesses.
- Take pictures of accident scene and vehicles. Refer to last page for instructions on what pictures to take.
